

City of The Village - Bulk Waste Guidelines

Bulky-waste days will be provided as follows:

- Tuesday Route: Bulk Waste 2nd Monday.
- Wednesday Route: Bulk Waste 1st Monday.
- Thursday Route: Bulk Waste 3rd Monday.
- Friday Route: Bulk Waste 4th Monday.

The rules for bulky waste are as follows:

- *Up to **three (3) cubic yards** of bulky waste may be placed at curbside each month. (3 cubic yards is roughly equivalent to six, 95-gallon polycarts)*
- *Bulky waste must not be placed at curbside more than 24 hours before your designated collection day.*
- ***PLEASE HAVE YOUR BULKY WASTE AT CURBSIDE NO LATER THAN 6 AM ON THE DAY OF PICKUP.***
- *Items must be placed at least five (5) feet from mailboxes, gas meters, cars, shrubs, or anything else that could interfere with hand loading or mechanical equipment.*
- *Items must be placed at least ten (10) feet away from utility poles, to prevent contact with overhead power lines.*
- *Bulky waste must be in a size and length that will fit in the hopper of the garbage truck.*
- *Small items or loose items such as twigs, paper, grass and other similar items must be **containerized in plastic bags or boxes** so that they do not spill.*
- *All items placed for collection must be able to be lifted and handled by two persons.*

Types of bulky waste that can be placed for collection include, but are not limited to the following:

- *Household appliances,*
- *Water tanks,*

- *Furniture,*
- *Mattresses,*
- *Cardboard boxes that are broken down and bundled.*
- *Trees, limbs and wood scrap tied and in two feet by four feet (2' x 4") bundles and not weighing more than (35) pounds.*
- *Fencing (up to 4 panels),*
- *Containerized non-contracted remodeling waste. (leftovers from do-it-yourself projects)*
- *Refrigerators and air conditioners provided they do not contain Freon. Such items may be placed out for collection only if the compressor is removed or the appliance has a sticker showing certified removal of the Freon.*
- **DO NOT** put any of the following items out for collection:
 - *Hospital or medical waste or hazardous waste of any kind;*
 - *Poisons, acids and caustics, explosives;*
 - *Dirt, rocks, bricks, or concrete;*
 - *Sewage and liquid waste,*
 - *Nuclear materials.*
 - *Gasoline, kerosene, oils, and other fuels;*
 - *Propane tanks, degreasers, lubricants, brake fluid, antifreeze, batteries, tires and rims, car batteries;*
 - *Sheet rock or roofing items;*
 - **Contracted** *construction, reconstruction, demolition, and repair waste.*

Bulk Waste Dumpsters: Residents may still take bulky wastes to the City's bulk waste disposal site located at 1701 NW 115th Street. Residents must have their City of The Village utility bill stub, a photo ID, and maintain an account in good standing to use the facility. Use of the dumpster is limited to two (2) pickup loads per billing cycle.

Beginning August 1, 2005, only the following will be accepted at the facility:

- *Residential Bulky wastes: (as listed above)*
- *Bagged grass: 20-bag limit.*
- *Brush: Tied and bundled in 2' x 4' lengths. 10-bundle limit.*
