



## ORDINANCE 743

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE, OKLAHOMA AMENDING CHAPTER 6, SECTION 6-202, SUBSECTION (D) PERTAINING TO RE-PERMITTING OF TEMPORARY CLASSROOM BUILDINGS; AMENDING CHAPTER 24, SECTION 326 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE; EXEMPTING TEMPORARY CLASSROOM BUILDINGS FROM ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN STANDARDS; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE:**

**Section 1.** That Chapter 6, Section 6-202 (d) of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (d) Temporary classroom or school accessory buildings that are moved onto private property within the city for use by a private school, provided that such temporary buildings are either removed or re-permitted within twenty-four (24) months. The city council may require screening of temporary classroom or school accessory buildings as may be deemed necessary in order to provide a buffer between temporary buildings and adjacent property.

**Section 2.** That Chapter 24, Section 24-326 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

**“Sec. 24-326. Applicability.**

The provisions of this Division apply to all commercial, office, public, institutional, and mixed-use buildings in all zoning districts, except for temporary classroom buildings permitted in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6, Section 6-202 of The Village City Code.”

**Section 3.** **Repealer Clause.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 4.** **Severability Clause.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance


**Section 5.** **Emergency Clause.** **WHEREAS**, it being necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, and safety of the City of The Village, Oklahoma, an emergency is declared to exist and by reason thereof this Ordinance shall take full force from and after its adoption.
