



ORDINANCE 755

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE, OKLAHOMA AMENDING CHAPTER 9, SECTION 9-281, SUBSECTION 2 F) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE; PERTAINING TO A STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT OF COMMERCIAL SITES; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE:

Section 1. That Chapter 9, Section 9-281, Subsection 2 f) of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

“f) For development or redevelopment occurring on a previously developed site, an applicant shall be required to include within the storm water concept plan measures for controlling storm water runoff discharges from the site with the goal and intent of restoring the land’s surface runoff to its pre-developed or virgin state in accordance with the standards of this Ordinance and to the maximum extent practicable.”

Section 2. Repealer Clause. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability Clause. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Emergency Clause. WHEREAS, it being necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, and safety of the City of The Village, Oklahoma, an emergency is declared to exist and by reason thereof this Ordinance shall take full force and effect from and after its adoption.
