



## ORDINANCE 758

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE, OKLAHOMA AMENDING CHAPTER 14, SECTION 14--27, SUBSECTION H) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE; PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN PENALTY ASSESSMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHANGES IN STATE LAW; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE:**

**Section 1.** That Chapter 14, Section 14-27, Subsection H) of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

“H) **Penalty Assessment.** The Municipal Court Clerk shall collect Penalty Assessment Fees on a finding of guilt for any offense for which the fine is greater than \$10 as follows:

- 1) *CLEET Assessment: \$10.00*
- 2) *AFIS Assessment: \$10.00*
- 3) *Forensic Assessment: \$10.00*

The fees listed herein shall not be assessed for parking violations or for the violation of seatbelt laws pursuant to 47, O.S. §12-417.

**Section 2. Repealer Clause.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 3. Severability Clause.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**Section 4. Emergency Clause.** **WHEREAS**, it being necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, and safety of the City of The Village, Oklahoma, an emergency is declared to exist and by reason thereof this Ordinance shall take full force and effect from and after its adoption.
