



## ORDINANCE 764

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE, OKLAHOMA AMENDING CHAPTER 13, SECTION 13-228, SUBSECTION 1 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF THE VILLAGE; ADOPTING PAVED PARKING STANDARDS FOR COMMERCIAL LOTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of The Village, Oklahoma:

**Section 1.** That Chapter 13, Section 13-228, Subsection 1 be amended to read as follows:

1. **Parking on Unpaved Surfaces.** Except as described in this Section, it shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on any unpaved surface on any residential or commercial lot.

**Section 2. Repealer Clause.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 3. Severability Clause.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional, such portion shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**Section 4. Emergency Clause.** WHEREAS, it being necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, and safety of the City of The Village, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and by reason thereof this Ordinance shall take full force and effect from and after its adoption.
