The City Council of the City of The Village, Oklahoma, met in special session at City Hall on Thursday, May 19, 2022, at 4:00 p.m., at 2304 Manchester Drive.

ITEM I: CALL TO ORDER.

Mayor Graham called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

ITEM II: DISCUSSION TO PRIORITIZE CAPITAL REQUESTS FOR POSSIBLE FUNDING IN THE FY 2022-23 BUDGET.

City Manager Bruce Stone presented preliminary budget figures for the purpose of determining how much money the Council could comfortably appropriate for capital expenditures. A necessary part of the discussion was to obtain direction on possible Cost of Living Adjustments for city employees and funding the employee health insurance plan. After a brief discussion, the Council tentatively agreed to a five percent, across the board, cost of living adjustment effective July 1, 2022. In addition, the Council tentatively approved a change in the Blue Cross & Blue Shield Health plan, reducing benefits to obtain a reduction in renewal rates from 27% to 13%.

The Council reviewed each capital request submitted and explained by the various departments at a Budget Work Session held on May 16, 2022. After review and discussion, The Council directed the city manager to eliminate some of the requests, add funds to others, and to include funds for webpage redesign and update.

The Council took no formal action.
