## DEFERRED SENTENCING/PROBATION FAQ

### **The court issued me a deferred sentence/probation agreement. What does this mean?**

The Court has agreed to dismiss the charge against you (with fines & costs) if you successfully complete the conditions laid out for you on your deferred sentence/probation agreement form.

### **Can I pay the fine right now?**

No. The fine listed on your probation agreement form is only valid if you successfully complete your probation and must be paid the week of your return court date.

### **Can I get on a payment plan for my fine?**

No. Fines ordered on deferred sentences/probation are not eligible for payment plans and must be paid in FULL the week of your return court date.

### **What forms of payment do you accept?**

We accept all forms of payment including cash, credit/debit cards (that are in your name), personal checks and money orders. Do **NOT** pay your citation online, as this will result in a conviction.

### **What do I need to bring with me on my return court date?**

You are responsible for returning with any fines/costs due, as well as all paperwork needed to prove you successfully completed your probation, except for your driving record.

### **The Court ordered me to complete an online driving school. What school should I use?**

**You may use ANY online defensive driving school of your choice that is accredited in the state of Oklahoma, and that you are completing for The Village Municipal Court. Some eligible schools are:**

## **The online driving school website said they would fax/mail/e-mail the certificate to you. Do I still have to bring a copy?**

YES! It is your responsibility to provide us with a copy of your certificate! For this reason, we suggest you complete your online driving school sooner rather than later.

## **What if I didn't complete my deferred sentence/probation terms in time, or got another ticket during my probation?**

Failure to comply with the terms of your probation may nullify the probation agreement, resulting in a conviction. If you would like, you may request a continuance from the Judge on your return date. **This may or may NOT be granted.**

If you would prefer to avoid appearing before the Judge, you may accept the charges, enter a plea and pay your ticket with the Municipal Court Office before your court date. If you choose to pay your ticket without receiving a continuance from the Judge on your deferred sentencing/probation agreement, the offense will go on your record.

## **What if I miss court?**

**Failure to return on your specified court date WILL result in a bench warrant being issued for your arrest and a charge of Failure to Appear in Court being filed, which carries fines & costs of \$820 and/or up to 60 days in the Oklahoma County Jail. Your driving privileges may also be suspended!**
