As continued from the two prior meetings, this item was presented to the Council. David Box and Tim Johnson spoke on behalf of Habitat For Humanity and The Habitat PUD in support of approval. Pastor Steve Evans of Our Lords Lutheran Church spoke in support of approval, Edward Saheb was followed by local residents Jack Jeffry Christie, Jessica Urbanas, Landon Prather, Willie Kelch, Charles Bruce McDermott, Charles Wenda, Craig Alman, Jim Abernathy, and Rachel Jackson spoke in opposition to the project.
